Irene is a perennial summer grass suitable for grazing, hay, silage and foggage in the winter season.

Ideal planting time ranges during October to November and February to March.

- Heterogeneous tufted grass variety
- Grows up to 1.2 m tall
- Leaf blade is glabrous, broad, spear-shaped; green-grey;
- 5 60 cm x 2 14 mm
- Small, slightly hairy seeds; brown 3.5 5 mm long; 2 000 000 seeds/kg
- Persistent and tolerant to drought
 Provides excellent grazing

 - Strong self-seeder thus long lifespan
